

Are you eligible for a Summary Dissolution in a Placer County divorce or Sacramento County divorce?

In order to qualify for a Summary Dissolution, you must meet all five of the following criteria:

Yes or No *Have been married for less than 5 years

Yes or No *Have no children together

Yes or No *Have no real estate together, even if one spouse has separate property real estate.

Yes or No *Have no debts exceeding \$5,000 not including car loans.

Yes or No *Have no combined assets (even if separate property) exceeding \$33,000

With this procedure, you do not need to appear in court and you may not need a lawyer, but it is in your best interest to discuss a Summary Dissolution with a Sacramento Divorce Lawyer before applying for a Summary Dissolution.
